YOUTH PROGRAMS

Youth Programs trains FSU students, faculty, and staff to work with elementary, middle, and high school students in the areas of reading, math, and science.

JUMPSTART

Jumpstart aims for every child in America to enter school prepared to succeed. Jumpstart ensures that those children most at-risk still reach this goal by providing extraordinary attention in yearlong, one-to-one relationships that inspire children to learn with the help of FSU mentors.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM

The Community Outreach Program provides students with an opportunity to get involved in community service on a regular basis. The projects are student-led and are offered at a variety of non-profit agencies on an almost daily basis.

SERVICESHIPS

Servicships are funded opportunities for students to focus 8-12 weeks on service to a non-profit agency, while contributing to the solution of a community need in a full-time capacity. Participants concentrate their service on a specific social need domestically or internationally.

SERVICE LEARNING

The Service Learning Program supports the integration of community service in the academic curriculum in order to enhance student learning, encourage student civic responsibility, foster community-based scholarship, and address community problems and social issues.

LEAD PLANS & STUDENT ADVISING

LEAD Plans are designed to develop Leaders Educated to make A Difference. As a result of completing a LEAD Plan, students learn the FSU leadership learning philosophy and resources of the Center. Advisors at the Center meet with students to learn what they care about, what their goals are, and what skills they want to gain during their academic careers at FSU. Advisors match students with programs, events, and other opportunities that will help them to achieve their goals.

LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATE

The 18 credit Certificate in Leadership Studies is an undergraduate program that is interdisciplinary, multidimensional, experiential, and multicultural. The certificate is offered through the Center and the Department of Educational Leadership and Policy Studies. Award of certificate is acknowledged on recipient's academic transcript.

SOCIAL JUSTICE LIVING-LEARNING COMMUNITY

The Social Justice Living-Learning Community (SJLLC) is located in Wildwood Hall. The SJLLC is designed for freshmen of all majors who desire to understand and practice social justice. Together students live, learn, and explore social activism, social change, and the philosophical foundations of justice. The leadership knowledge and skills gained from academic coursework and co-curricular programming equip students to initiate and bring about positive social change.

LEADERSHAPE

Occurring annually the first week of May, the Institute is an intensive and energizing six-day program that exists to inspire, develop, and support students who have a commitment to lead with a high level of integrity.

MISSION

The Center enhances the education of students for responsible citizenship and effective leadership.

VISION

Students and alumni are responsible citizens and effective leaders. They are aware of and engaged in the world around them and use their talents and means to create a more just and humane society. Students and alumni are well-known and respected for their leadership acumen and public service tradition. They readily seek and accept opportunities for leadership; partake actively in professional, civic, and community organizations; offer themselves for positions of trust and public service; and strive to make positive changes in their professions and communities



LEAD-INS AT THE REZ

Lead-Ins at the Rez are overnight, retreat-style, leadership learning experiences hosted by the Center and the FSU Reservation. These sessions focus on the development of leadership knowledge, skills, and values. Meals, lodging, and materials are provided free for participants.

MAKE A DIFFERENCE TALLAHASSEE

Make A Difference Tallahassee is an annual, community-wide day of service designed to unite the college community with the local community to volunteer side-by-side at agencies across Tallahassee, in an effort to make a positive difference in this community.

NOLES LEADERSHIP BOOK CLUB

This is a campus book club, open to all students, faculty, and staff. Members come together to respond, react, and apply lessons learned from a current leadership text. Members register with the Center and commit to three breakfast conversations.

SERVICE LEADERSHIP SEMINAR

This three and a half-day seminar provides an opportunity for incoming freshmen to learn about community service and leadership. The seminar includes community service projects, workshops, speakers, and interaction with current campus leaders.

SERVICE SCHOLAR PROGRAM

FSU recruits students into this four-year, service leadership program. It incorporates individual and group service, skill building, reflection, and fellowship. Service Scholars receive a scholarship for their active participation.

SERVE2LEARN SERIES

The Serve2Learn series offers education, training, and development opportunities for students involved in service and leadership organizations.
