Grace Mission Church

Grace Mission is a 16-year old ministry to help reach those who are often forgotten by society; the homeless, poor, underemployed, addicted, etc. Our charge is to serve, care for, and love the most vulnerable among us, including the children. Our year-round children's program includes an after-school program on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3-6pm in Tallahassee's largest public housing project, Springfield Apts, at 1700 Joe Louis Street. Volunteers can sign up for either or both days and for any of the three segments of the afternoon: creative play (3-4pm), tutoring/homework (4-5pm), or dinner service (4:30-6pm).
